The Science team at Kineton is a supportive and collaborative group of professionals, who are passionate about ensuring that all students achieve their best in Science. The team currently consists of 9 teachers (3 part time) and 3 technicians. It is soon to be joined by an additional part-time teacher in April 2023. The subject is taught in a purpose-built block which was opened in 2017. This block will continue to be the home of Science when the school's brand new building opens in 2024.

Traditionally at Kineton, the subject is taught by specialists in Chemistry, Biology and Physics throughout each key stage. The curriculum is clearly structured and well resourced.
